## act 1 curation

*Commonplace* is a collaborative exhibition based on the interaction between curators and artists united to shed light on the collection of the Museum of Contemporary Art of the University of São Paulo. Thought of as a work in progress, this exhibition takes place in three acts over five months, resulting in three different spatial conformations presented on the 5th floor of the museum's venue. The proposal is to make room for curatorship to be experienced as a shared process between the curators, the artists selected for the exhibition and the invited interlocutors.

The choice for the exhibition's name moves in the opposite direction of the current definition, which considers the commonplace as synonymous of something banal, or something that loses the strength of its original meaning by over-repetition. Instead, the term is understood as what is ordinary, which belongs to everyday life and is then transfigured when integrated into works of art. At the same time, another meaning overlaps with the first, from the possibility of creating a "commonplace" negotiated between the members of the group and built in the face of otherness.

The first act inaugurates the exhibition with 15 works belonging to the museum's collection, selected by curators Ana Magalhães, Helouise Costa and Marta Bogéa. This first moment comprises pieces by Carmela Gross, Ding Musa, Emmanuel Nassar, Jessica Mein, Laercio Redondo, Marcelo Zocchio, Nina Moraes, Rodrigo Bivar, Rogério Ghomes, Rommulo Vieira Conceição, Rosângela Rennó and Gustavo Von Ha. In the second act, the artists reflect on their works in dialogue with six guests: Claudinei Roberto, Claudio Mubarac, Paulo Pasta, Paulo Garcez, Regina Silveira and Tadeu Chiarelli. Next, artists freely choose others works that, when inserted in the exhibition, establish articulations or counterpoints capable of generating unforeseen meanings.

Finally, in the third and final act, the whole group involved in the exhibition collectively selects the works that complete the set, ending the process. *Commonplace* discusses the curatorial authority of the museum, the relationship between art and everyday life, and the possibilities of renewal of an institutional collection based on new readings resulting from the possible dialogues between different ways of seeing the world.
