




Graphic Experimentations is part of a series of exhibitions about applied arts that MAC USP has presented since 2021, the first one being *Projects for a modern daily life in Brazil, 1920-1960* (2021), and the second, *Fulvia and Adolpho Leirner Collection of Brazilian Art Déco* (2022). They result from the research developed by the CNPq Research Group Narratives of the art of the 20th century, focused on investigating the relationship between the so-called fine arts (painting and sculpture) and the largely entitled applied arts, in Brazil.


Here, the highlight is to the graphic arts and the experience of Brazilian artists from the second half of the 20th century on, with means of communication, like newspapers, illustrated magazines and the national editorial system. Curators Renata Rocco, Francis Melvin Lee and Mariana Motta worked from the donation of 89 pieces of Brazilian illustrated magazines and publications of the period, made to the Museum library Lourival Gomes Machado. In them, we see great names, such as Fayga Ostrower, Regina Silveira, Emiliano Di Cavalcanti, Aldemir Martins, Tomás Santa Rosa, Noêmia Mourão, among others, acting as illustrators and graphic artists. They are put in dialogue with works by the same artists in the collections of MAC USP, so as to give the audience the opportunity to appreciate their experimentation and creation in various technical media and dimensions.

These magazines and publications were donated by the Collection Ivani and Jorge Yunes. Their selection for MAC USP was made by curator Renata Rocco, who as post-doctoral researcher of the Thematic Project FAPESP Collect. Identify. Process. Exhibit. The curatorial cycle and the construction of knowledge (2018-2023), collaborated with the CNPq Research Group Narratives of the art of the 20th century, and shared with other young scholars the investigation, selection and curatorship of the exhibitions we did in 2021 and 2022.

MAC USP is a public, university museum, as well as a key place for scientific-academic dissemination, in which curatorship is defined by the process of collecting, identifying, preserving/documenting, and exhibiting artworks. The donation Ivani and Jorge Yunes reflects this principle.



In 2023, Collection Ivani and Jorge Yunes donated to the MAC USP Library 89 volumes published in the 20th Century and illustrated by modern artists in Brazil. Part of this donation, together with works from the Museum's, Yunes' and other collections, raised two reflections for this exhibition: 1. demonstrate the collaboration and the transit of modern and contemporary artists between the so-called "fine arts" and "graphic arts" and 2. revisit publications and authors from the 1920s to 2000s, not limited to Rio-São Paulo axis and not always accessible to the public.

In the first case, we see the versatility of artists in different media. Their creations show that there is no hierarchy among graphic productions, since that the power of their traits goes beyond classifications. When seen in a panoramic view, the works show the variety of artistic solutions, as well as our understanding of what was a modern visual language throughout the last century.

In the second case, publications such as *O Cruzeiro*, *Diários Associados*, *Mapa* and *O Saco* highlight political, economic, cultural, environmental and social issues in the heat of the moment, such as, for example, the celebration of the IV Centenary of the city of São Paulo, the propaganda of coffee as the city's economic engine and the drought in the Northeast region.

What permeates the exhibition is the power of images, their use to express an idea of modernity in different Brazilian cities and the close cooperation of artists with this project.

We understand that this research needs to be expanded. From the inclusion of other graphic pieces – such as advertisements and posters – to other artists and periodicals that are less known today, but that compose a complex picture of the visualities and subjects that circulate among us.
